Jasmine Chen 陈胤希

Jazz Vocalist · Songwriter · Jazz Educator

Born in Liaoning, China, into a family of professional performers, Jasmine Chen moved to England at nineteen to study classical piano at Leeds Conservatoire, graduating with honours in 2004. It was there she discovered jazz — and chose to dedicate her life to it.

Returning to Shanghai in 2005, she began building a singular voice: Western jazz tradition fused with Chinese musical heritage, folk songs reimagined, standards rewritten in Mandarin, and original compositions capturing contemporary Chinese life.

She is the first Chinese vocalist to perform at both the North Sea Jazz Festival (Rotterdam) and the Aarhus Jazz Festival (Denmark), and has performed across Europe, Southeast Asia, Australia, and the Americas.

Today, Jasmine Chen is one of China's most internationally recognised jazz vocalists — equally at home in an intimate Shanghai salon or on a concert hall stage in Budapest, Singapore, or South Africa.

Personally invited by director Jon M. Chu, Jasmine performed six songs for the film — three selected for the Official Original Motion Picture Soundtrack, released globally on vinyl, CD, and digital by Water Tower Music. She also appears in two scenes as herself.

Crazy Rich Asians topped the North American box office for multiple consecutive weeks, earning Golden Globe and Critics' Choice nominations. It was Hollywood's first major studio release with an all-Asian principal cast in 25 years — and Jasmine's music was at the heart of its most cinematic moments.



The film received numerous honors, including recognition at the 2018 Golden Globe Awards and the Critics' Choice Awards.

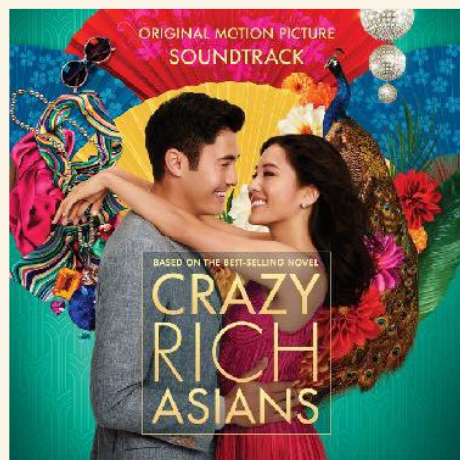

Smaller formats offer intimacy, subtlety, and close connection with guests, while larger ensembles bring greater scale, richness, and dramatic impact for major celebrations, festival stages, and high-profile events. This flexibility makes Jasmine equally suited to refined, atmosphere-led occasions and more expansive productions where the music is expected to leave a lasting impression.

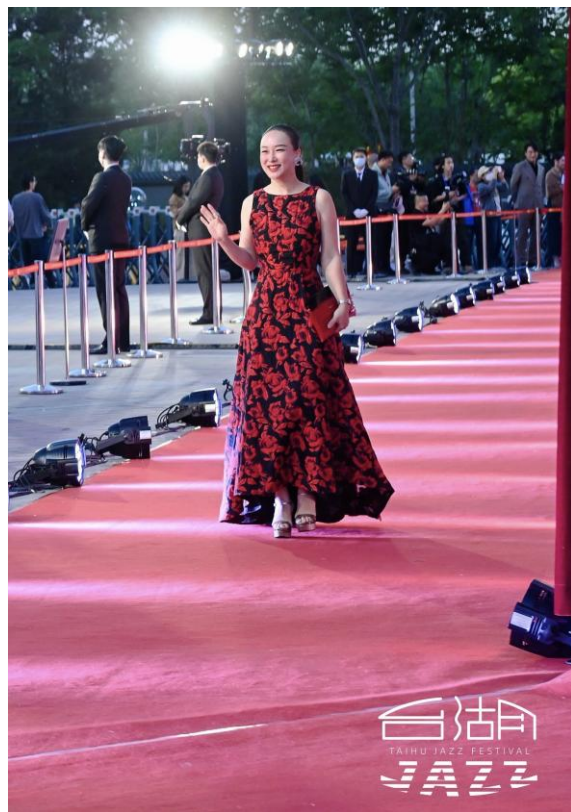
